

The Five College Center for East Asian Studies (FCCEAS) is now accepting applications from K-12 educators and the general public for <u>Walking the Tōkaidō: A Self-Guided Multi-Disciplinary Experience</u>. Walk (or run or bike) the 310 miles from Edo (Tokyo) to Kyoto at your own speed and learn about Japan while you do it! Log your miles on a virtual platform and view the route via Google Street View. At each of seventeen milestones participants will receive an e-mail with historical and cultural information about the places they "visit" during their journey.
